Writing YOUR "Letter to the Bishop"

1. Start off with "Dear Bishop _____"
2. Next write two indented paragraphs telling the Bishop:
 - a. Why do you want to be Confirmed (be honest...)
 - b. How have you grown in your faith life over the past two years?
 - i. What experiences affected you? Why?
 - ii. Do you pray more now?
 - iii. How do you see God in your life now?
 - iv. What service opportunities did you do? How did they affect you?
 - v. What were the retreats like? How did you experience the Holy Spirit?
 - vi. What have you learned?
3. Lastly, give realistic examples of how you plan to live out your Confirmation commitment after you have received the Sacrament.
4. At the end, thank him by writing something like: "Thank you for reading my letter" or "I'm looking forward to meeting you on the day of our Confirmation ceremony," or something similar.
5. End your letter with, "Sincerely," or "In Christ," or "Peace in Christ," or "Blessings," or something similar.
6. Type out your full name and sign below!
